Snapshot of the church's regular expenses:

- Weekly donation for Sunday worship space at St. Andrew's Church—R10,000
- Sunday School material every six months—\$500
- One refugee food bag will provide one person food for one month—R450
- One meal at the Universitet Soup Kitchen—R75
- Weekly total medical subscription supplement program—R5,000
- Weekly total for medical staff in our medical consultation center—R8,000
- One night in our emergency shelter program—R600
- Repatriate one person to home country—\$1,000
- Monthly rent for Parish Center—\$1,250
- One monthly metro pass for staff—R2,380
- Monthly expense for church car and driver for Food Bank and Parish Center deliveries—\$1,200
- Monthly rent for church parsonage (pastor's apartment)—\$3,000
